COMMUNITY-BASED AND FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES

People Inc. provides individualized programs to enhance the well-being and futures of children, adults with developmental disabilities and their caregivers, from in-home care to supported living in the community. Our programs include:

COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Age: Varies

An in-home support program that works with families of children and adults with developmental disabilities who exhibit maladaptive behaviors.

COMMUNITY HABILITATION Age: 18+

Community Habilitation is a service designed to promote independence and community integration by offering skills training and other supports.

CONSUMER DIRECTED PERSONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Age: All

Participants are responsible to coordinate and manage their home care services, including hiring, training, supervising and scheduling their staff. The program is for people (or their legal guardians) who are able to make informed choices. Medicaid eligibility required.

ENVIRONMENTAL MODIFICATIONS/ ADAPTIVE TECHNOLOGIES

Age: All

The environmental modification, "emod," is an adaptation to the home that increases or maintains the person's ability to live in his/her home. The program addresses needs related to physical, behavioral or sensory abilities, and helps ensure the person's health and safety are met.

FAMILY ADVOCACY TRAINING AND SUPPORT Age: Under 18

This program is designed to help individuals and families increase independence in a variety of skill areas. While informational sessions are offered to families who may need assistance with understanding and better supporting their loved one with developmental disabilities.

FAMILY REIMBURSEMENT

Age: All

An income-based program that assists families with providing various goods and services to their loved ones currently living at home.

GUARDIANSHIP

Age: 18+

The program ensures that people with a developmental disability are provided for when the current guardian is no longer able to act on his or her behalf.

INCREDIBLE YEARS PROGRAM

Age: 3-12

Designed to teach parents how to foster positive behaviors in their children, and to develop effective techniques for dealing with behavior issues.

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT MENTORING Age: 18+

A Personal Development Mentor (PDM) helps bridge the gap between where a person is and where they want to be by assisting with problem solving, decision making and goal attainment in daily life. This is a transitional, three to six month program that focuses on skill-building with an emphasis on community integration.

PEOPLE INC. HOME HEALTH

Services assist people with and without developmental disabilities who are in need of acute medical care or assistance with daily living. Services are in Erie and Niagara Counties, including: in-home nursing; physical, occupational and speech therapy; nutrition and medical social work.

POOLED TRUST PROGRAM

Age: All

Aae: All

Provides options when planning financial needs. A supplemental needs trust enables a loved one's quality of life to be enhanced, without causing the loss of government benefits.

RESPITE SERVICES

Age: Varies

Aae: All

For many families, respite is crucial to caring for a loved one with a developmental disability. A variety of respite services are provided to meet personal needs.

SELF-DIRECTED SERVICES

This person-centered program encourages people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families to manage their own plan.

Services are based on their needs and provide support to experience personal growth, live as independently as possible, work, volunteer, pursue recreational and social activities, and more!

SUPPLEMENTAL DAY HABILITATION

Age: 18+

An alternative day habilitation program that provides a fun and safe environment to learn and grow for people with developmental disabilities. Goals are determined by the person's interests and needs, which may include socialization, money and safety skills.
